

Pine Hill Park Rules

- Users of Pine Hill Park trails do so at their own risk.
- The Park is Open for day use only. No Camping, No Fires.
- Keep the Park Clean and Beautiful. Pack out what you pack in. **DON'T LITTER!**
- Some trails are bike or pedestrian use only, or may be closed due to wet conditions, etc. **PLEASE OBEY POSTED RESTRICTIONS ON TRAIL USE.**
- Please park in the designated area at Giorgetti Park.
- Dogs must be under control at all times.
- Some trails leave park lands. Please observe park boundaries and respect private property.
- Disruptive behavior is prohibited.
- Disturbing, removing, defacing, cutting or damaging plants, animals or man-made features in the park is prohibited.
- Discharge of firearms, bow and arrows, paintball guns or fireworks is prohibited in the park. **NO HUNTING IN THE PARK.**

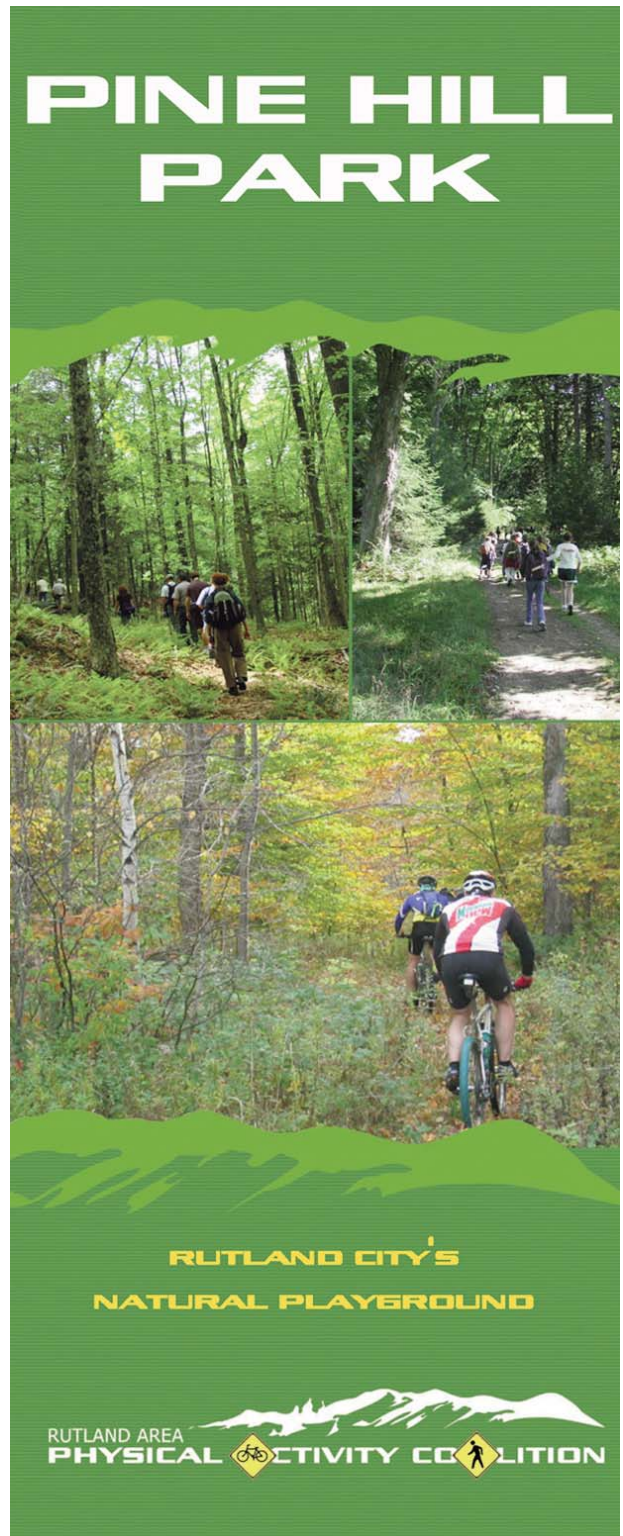
This map is an artistic representation of the trails in Pine Hill Park. It is not perfectly accurate.

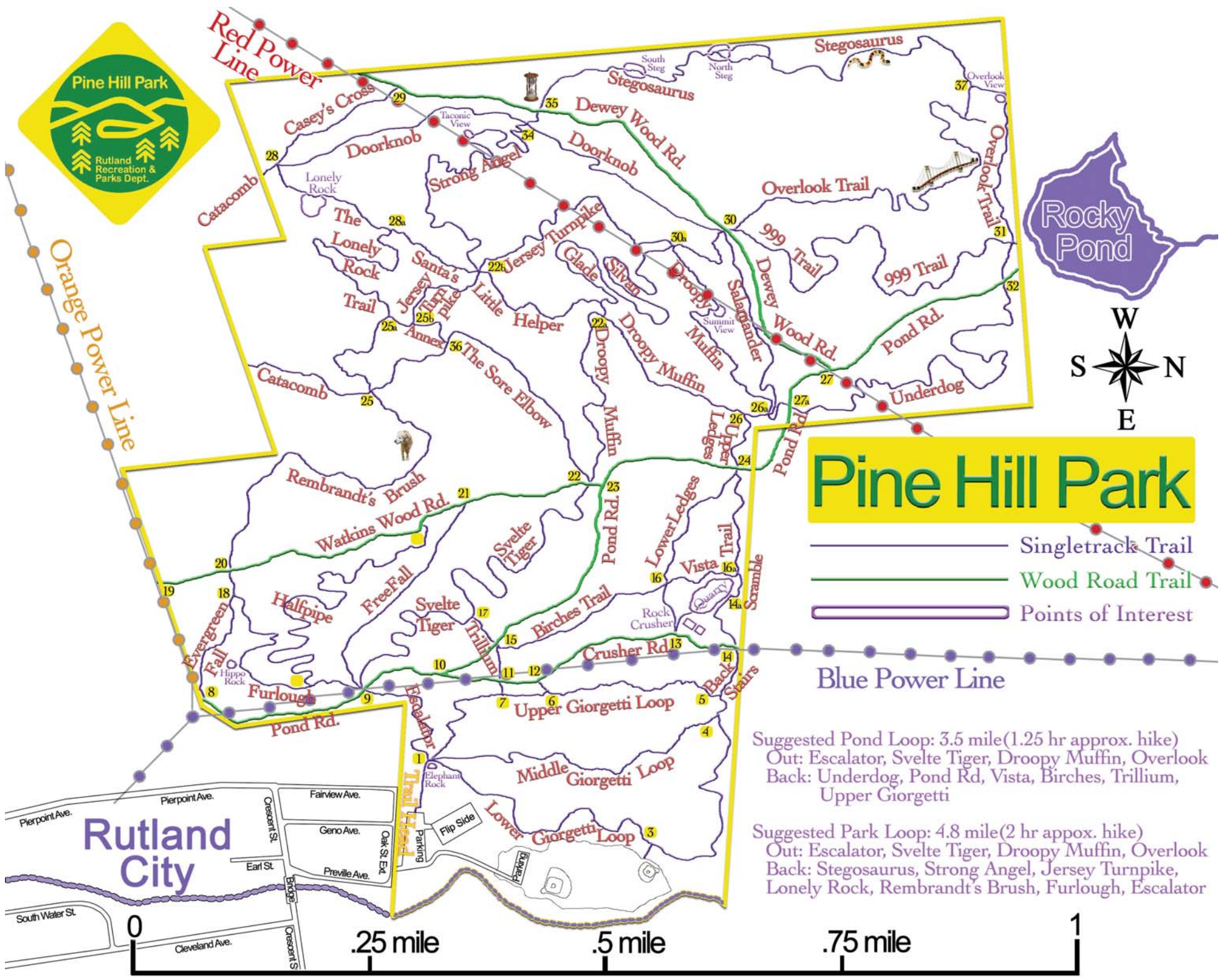


Pine Hill Park is located in the northwest corner of Rutland City. Take Crescent to Preville Avenue and enter at the Giorgetti Athletic Complex

 Back: Underdog, Pond Rd, Vista, Birches, Trillium, Upper Giorgetti

Suggested Park Loop: 4.8 mile (2 hr approx. hike)
 Out: Escalator, Svelte Tiger, Droopy Muffin, Overlook
 Back: Stegosaurus, Strong Angel, Jersey Turnpike, Lonely Rock, Rembrandt's Brush, Furlough, Escalator
